In order to maintain a safe and enjoyable learning environment DCDS/PYC have developed the following Code of Conduct.

All safety procedures given by coaches and other responsible adults will be followed.

PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICES must be worn when in boats and at other times as directed. Unauthorized swimming is not permitted.

Sportsmanlike conduct is expected of students at all times, on and off the water. Foul language, disruptive behavior or disrespectful comments or gestures will not be tolerated.

Team equipment and property will be used only under the direction of the coaches. All equipment will be returned to its proper storage areas upon completion clean and properly stored.

Students' personal gear will be properly stored. Unauthorized use of the team's equipment or other students' equipment is not permitted. Any damage must be immediately reported. Malicious destruction of property will not be tolerated.

Pushing, shoving and other physical abuse are not allowed. Fighting is subject to immediate suspension from the program.

Students will not leave the program without first obtaining the Sailing Master's permission.

Should a student neglect to abide by the Code of Conduct he/she may be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to:

Reprimand

Calisthenics (pushups, etc.)

Work detail

Suspension from classes

Expulsion from the program
Fines for malicious abuse of equipment

US/MS Sailing Team/PYC prohibits the following activities during program hours or on program premises. These include smoking, the use of alcohol, illegal use of controlled substances or carrying of weapons. Participation in these activities will result in immediate suspension, appearance before the Conduct Review Board with probable dismissal from the program.

Guardians are required to immediately remove any students from the program that is suspended or expelled.

There will be no refunds or pre-registration of fees for suspension or expulsions.
